---

- In-person orientation and preparation class to prepare for your trip to Salt Lake City

- Seven nights at the Salt Lake Plaza Hotel, including free Internet
- Meet and greet on Sunday evening at the hotel
- Six days of research at the Family Search Library
- Wednesday evening no-host dinner/social
- Research volunteers and specialists available at the Family Search Library upon request
- Free printing of documents, lunchroom availability, ADA handicapped access at the library
- A nice bunch of people to hang out with during the week!

### Registration Fees

---

- \$25 for SLOCGS members including SMVGS members, \$40 for non-members
- For a non-researching accompanying spouse/partner, please add \$20, as the spouse/partner will enjoy the group hotel rate. A non-researching spouse/partner is not eligible to attend the SLOCGS prep class.
- Space permitting, you may register for this research trip up until April 1, 2022, with the understanding that you may miss the prep class, the pre-trip social and/or possibly the discounted group hotel the later you register.
- PLEASE NOTE: After April 1, 2022, all registration fees are non-refundable regardless of your reason for canceling.

### Preparation Class

Upon receipt of your registration form and fee, we will place you on the approved list for the Research Trip Preparation Class on January 29, 2022. The prep class will focus on how to prepare for the best results from the research trip as well as what to bring, what restaurants and food stores are available as well as transportation, facilities at the library, etc. Bring questions!

## Accessibility

Cabs, hotel parking (\$10/day with in/out privileges), and public transit are extra fees, if needed. Salt Lake City has an excellent bus and light rail transit system, and the hotel is within the Free Fare Zone. The transit system is called TRAX and is available from directly outside the airport to across the street from the hotel for \$2.50 each way with senior discount available (fare as of Nov 2021).
